

## CORAL WOOD PRIMER

(CPR 4)

### Product description:

#### Type

Alkyd based coral wood primer has a supreme quality, multi-purpose primer for soft wood, plywood, and chipboards, which provides a flexible, non-absorbent surface to be primed.

#### Features and benefits

Brushes deep into cracks, filling minor irregularities. Durable and has Good coverage, obliterating and sanding properties. It provides a sound base for the subsequent finishing coat.

#### Recommended use

Suitable for interiors and exteriors and can be used on all type soft surfaces, i.e. on soft wood, ply wood and chipboards as an appropriate primer.

#### Substrate

General-purpose primer for application on wood, plywood.

### Application data:

#### The product can be applied by

**Brush, Roller** : Recommended.

**Spray Application:** (refer to spray gun manufacturer's information)

- **Conventional gun** : Fluid Tip 1.3 – 1.6mm, Air pressure 50 psi (3.5 bar) at the gun
- **HVLP/Compliant gun** : Fluid Tip 1.2 – 1.5mm, Air pressure

#### Film thickness per coat

##### Typical recommended range

Theoretical Coverage: 8-10 m<sup>2</sup>/ liter

Film thickness will vary and is calculated as average.

Spreading rate depends on film thickness applied, type of texture, surface porosity, imperfections, temperature, wastage during painting etc.

Maximum spread rate per coat is obtained at minimum dry film thickness.

### Thinner

Coral Solvents for Oil Paints T-100/Gloss Thinner

### Dilution

Maximum 8-10 % by Volume for Spray Application

### Special Remark

Do not apply un-recommended top coat on red oxide primer.  
When applying Gloss on glossy surface the first coat should be lightly abraded with fine sandpaper to guarantee good inter-coat adhesion.

### Conditions during application

The temperature of the substrate should be minimum 10 °C and at least 3 °C above the dew point of the air, measured in the vicinity of the substrate. Good ventilation is usually required in confined areas to ensure proper drying.

### Drying times

Drying times are generally related to air circulation, temperature, film thickness and number of coats, and will be affected correspondingly.

1. Recommended data given is, for recoating with the same generic type of paint.
2. In case of multi-coat application, drying times will be influenced by the number and sequence and by the total thickness of previous coats applied.
3. The surface should be dry and free from any contamination prior to application of the subsequent coat.

## Directions for use:

### Surface preparation

The substrate must be clean, dry and free from dust, oil, grease, laitance etc. All traces of form release agents/curing agents must be removed. A light sanding with suitable abrasive material is recommended before application. Any resulting dust/loose particles must be removed.

### Recommended paint system

- Coral Wood Primer : 1 Coat
- Coral Enamel Finish : 2 - 3 Coat

**\*It can change depending on Shade & Substrate.**

### **Remarks:**

Other systems may be specified, depending on area of use.

Masking tape has to be removed immediately after application of the topcoat.

Contents of packaging with different batch numbers must be mixed together before use. .

---

### **Storage:**

The product must be stored in accordance with national regulations. Keep the containers in a dry, cool, well ventilated space and away from sources of heat and ignition. Containers must be kept tightly closed. Handle with care.

---

### **Environmental labelling:**
